Super League Rules

Season 2025-26

1. All Super League games are best of 7 x 501 Legs (Men) and 4 x 501 (Ladies) with each team to consist of 7 (Men) or 4 (Ladies). The minimum number of players to play a valid game is a team of 5 (Men) or 2 (Ladies).
2. The entry fee will be £50 per team. Paid before the start of the season.
3. Each player needs to be UKDA registered in order to be eligible to play, a registration form along with a fee of £15 for each player must be Given to Paul Moody by or on Aug 3rd 2025. Players may be signed up on match day however, the opposing team must be made aware of the new player and the players registration form and fee must be submitted to Paul Moody no later than the following Monday after the match.
4. Playing an unregistered player will result in a loss of the point (if he/she won) plus another one point per occasion.
5. Both the Home and Away teams are responsible to ensure the match sheet is correctly filled in however, it is the home team's responsibility to send in the match sheet to ptmoody@ptmoody.karoo.co.uk.
6. All result sheets will need to be submitted no later than the Monday following the match by 12 noon. To ptmoody@ptmoody.karoo.co.uk Failure to comply will mean a no result and no points will be awarded to the home team.
7. The score sheets will be completed as per the UKDA rules, only these sheets may be used either in A4 or A3 format, or a match summary from Darts for Windows can be submitted.
8. Teams who wish to cancel ONE HOME fixture must inform the Super League Secretary no later than the 7 days before the fixture is due to be played unless it is an emergency, it us up to the captains to rearrange the fixture and inform the Super League Secretary of the new date. In this instance, the none cancelling team MUST provide the other team with three dates for the fixture to be rearranged. The team which cancelled MUST choose one of

these dates. Failure to comply will result in a penalty. Team's MUST advise the Super League Secretary. Please note this is a fair game we play and ask all Team Captain's to bear this in mind when a cancelled game is inevitable, all reasonable steps should be taken to accommodate the fixture, so no penalties are given.

9. If a team turns up to play a fixture with less than the full complement of players, the match will still be contested to the maximum number of games. For example, if a Men's team only plays five players, then five games will be played but the team with only 5 players will forfeit the other points which will be awarded to the opposing team, all players to go into draw for players without a match they have to play opposing players drawn from the match. The Ladies applies to two players.
10. Following the drawing of names to determine the order of play, if a player refuses to play another team's player for whatever reason, then the player refusing to play will forfeit that game (4-0 Men's, 3-0 Ladies) and the point will be awarded to the player who is not refusing to play, however no averages will be given for the match. If this occurs the Super League Secretary MUST be informed of the incident.
11. All fixtures are to be played no later than June 6th / 7th 2026.
12. No baseball caps to be worn whilst playing unless they have medical Proof, cannot have Four Darts in hand whilst at oche.
